Pinecroft Christian Camp endeavors to maintain a low cost camping experience so that camp is a viable option financially for as many campers as possible. The cost per day for each staff member for lodging is \$14 and \$8 a day for meals. CODE OF CONDUCT

Pinecroft Christian Camp staff members represent Christ first, camp second. We respect the fact that there are a wide range of convictions and scriptural principles. As a result, Pinecroft staff will abide by the following code of conduct. This code of conduct is not the Ten Commandments; in fact, much is based on appearances and cultural perspective, however we believe that they are vital and essential to minister effectively while at camp.

Personal Discipline

Christian maturity and growth do not happen on their own. Each staff member will be expected to invest in personal spiritual growth through daily Bible study and prayer.

Conduct / Appearance of Evil

We expect the conduct of all of our staff to be consistent with Christian faith and ethics (selfishness and bad attitudes are not allowed). Also required is a desire to live a Christ-like lifestyle (see Ephesians 5:1-2).

Harassment / Abuse

We want to maintain an atmosphere that is free from all forms of Harassment and Abuse. This includes sexual, emotional, verbal, physical, and racial abuse.

Sexual Conduct and Activity

It is expected that while working on staff at Pinecroft, all staff will avoid any sexual conduct or activity with other staff (outside of the marriage relationship). This includes all public displays of affection (i.e. kissing, holding hands, and back rubs). Any staff / camper dating or flirting is strictly prohibited. Sexual interaction of any kind between staff and campers is strictly prohibited.

Usage of Alcohol and Illegal drugs

While working at Pinecroft, all staff is to abstain from the usage of alcohol and illegal drugs. Any usage will result in immediate dismissal from the staff and premises.

Smoking or use of Tobacco Products

It is expected that while working at Pinecroft all staff will abstain from smoking or use of tobacco products on and off camp property.

Promptness

It is expected of all staff to be on time to meetings, meal times, and program assignments.

Authority

Each staff person will be under the authority of the Pinecroft managing staff. Respectful and joyful submission are what God has called us to do. (Romans 13:1) Keep in mind all staff, even the Dean and Director, are under someone's authority and we all are under the authority of God.

Leading by Example

All staff are expected to lead our campers by example in abiding with camp rules and policies in all areas including dress code and electronics and media.

Dress code

SWIM WEAR:

Female: (**midriff MUST be covered**) Medium neckline. No plunge or low scoop fronts. No extreme scooped or plunging backs. No high cut thighs. No white suits (*too many are see through when wet*). No "see through" suits (*wet or dry*). No thong style.

Male: (**MUST be boxer style**) No spandex. No white trunks. No see through trunks (*wet or dry*).

DAILY DRESS:

Female: No halter tops or spaghetti straps.

Male: Shirts are to be worn at all times (*even during sports activities*).

Male or Female: Shorts are to be mid-thigh in length. No bike shorts or running pants (*i.e. not body hugging*). No midriffs (*tops must cover stomach/waist*). No clothes advertising drugs, alcohol or tobacco. No clothing can have foul language on it. No clothing with inappropriate logos, sayings, or pictures.

NOTE: The Camp Dean or Director will have final say on what is considered appropriate/modest dress.

Electronics and Media

Pinecroft is an "unplugged" environment. All staff are expected to lead by example and refrain from carrying or using electronic devices including cell phones, laptops, mp3 players, etc. Cell phone usage will be limited to the Dean, Director, Nurse, and Lifeguard for camp purposes. Laptop usage will only be by designated staff for camp purposes. Alarm clocks are provided for each cabin.

RELEASE AND ARBITRATION AGREEMENT

(Must be signed by all attendees)

IN CONSIDERATION OF the use of the camp facilities owned/ or operated by The Dalkena Community Church , Pend Oreille Bible Camp, and Pinecroft Christian Camp by myself or one or more of my children or wards, I, for myself, or the minor child named below, forever waive, release and discharge PINECROFT CHRISTIAN CAMP or PEND OREILLE BIBLE CAMP and its parent corporation, THE DALKENA COMMUNITY CHURCH from any/all injuries, claims, disputes, liabilities, or actions resulting from the use of the camp, regardless of location, from July 10, 2016 through and including July 29, 2016. I attest and verify that I have full knowledge of the risks and dangers involved; that I assume such risks, and that I will assume and pay my own medical expenses, in the event of an accident, illness or other incapacity, regardless of whether I have authorized such expenses.

Any controversy arising out of, connected to, or relating to this Release and Agreement between me and the above named parties or on behalf of the minor child named below, or the breach thereof, including, but not limited to any claims of violations of Federal and/or State Law, as well as any common law claims shall be settled by arbitration through the Christian Conciliation Services: and in accordance with this paragraph a judgment based upon the arbitrator's award may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof in accordance with the provisions of R.C.W. 7.04. This agreement shall be construed and interpreted under the laws of the State of Washington.
